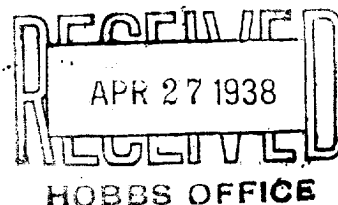

10 3/4" Lapweld casing has been set at 251' and cemented with 200 sacks of common cement. 10 a.m. 4/25/38. The well will be allowed to stand undisturbed for 48 hours, after which the cement plug will be drilled and the hole bailed dry. After remaining undisturbed for 1 hour, the hole will again be bailed to determine the presence of water. If there is none, drilling will be resumed.
