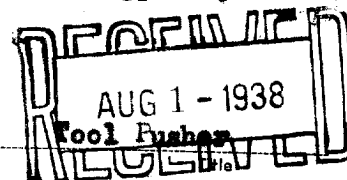

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

With 7" OD seamless casing set at 4311' and cemented with 200 sacks of common cement, the well was allowed to stand undisturbed for a period of 72 hours. Pump pressure of 1200# was applied to the pipe and fittings, the valves closed, and the pressure observed for a period of 30 minutes. There was no drop in pressure. The cement plug was then drilled and a similar test applied, with no drop in pressure. Drilling was resumed 7/28/38.
