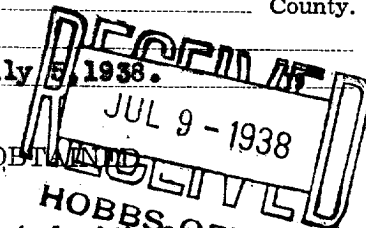

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

With 9 5/8" seamless casing set at 1641' and cemented with 250 sacks, the well was allowed to stand undisturbed for a period of 72 hours. Pump pressure of 1200# was applied to the pipe and fittings, the valves closed, and the pressure observed for thirty minutes. There was no drop in pressure. The cement plug was then drilled and a leak test applied. There was no drop in pressure. Drilling was resumed 7/7/38
