13" OD casing set and cemented with 200 sacks at 227' was allowed to stand undisturbed for 48 hours. The cement plug was then drilled and the hole bailed dry. The well was allowed to stand undisturbed for 1 hour and the bailer was again run. No water had accumulated. Drilling was resumed.
