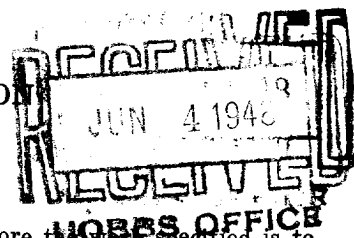

This well was completed February 26, 1940, total depth 4605'. 7" OD casing was set at 4280' w/210 sax; initial production at time of completion was 63 bbls. 1st 24 hrs, 152 bbls. 2nd 24 hrs. Present production is 5 bbls. oil per day.

It is the Magnolia's intention to drill this well approximately 50' deeper to explore the Vacuum field pay zone for production.
