DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

T. B. 4706' Lime. Loaded hole with 160 bbls. oil & introduced 1000 gallons Dowell XX. Blod x 5 bbls. oil off casing while introducing acid thru tubing, controlling treatment from bottom back up to 4450'. Flushed tubing with 16 bbls. oil. Swabbed off bottom 8 hours recovering 154 bbls. oil load & acid. At end of 8th hour of swabbing well came to life & flowed 118 bbls. oil, 0 water in 7 hours. Shut well in until noon 6th, opened & took 6 hour test. Flowed 98 bbls. oil, 0 water. Gas measured 55,000 cu. ft. daily. Gas/Oil Ratio 140.
