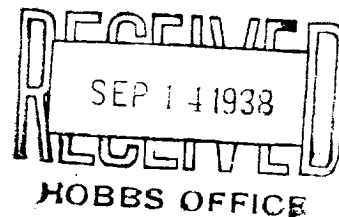

The Texas Company's State of N. M. "Q" #3 has been completed at at a total depth of 4725'; swabbing 8 bbls per hour. After three stage acid treatment well has insufficient gas to flow and we therefore propose to set a high pressure separator at State of N.M. "L" #1 and use the gas which in being produced with the oil through the tubing to gas lift State of N.M. "Q" #3. This gas would otherwise be blown to the air.
