DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Total depth - 4725' Lime.

This well was shot on 11-1-38 with 300 quarts of nitroglycerin from 4474' to 4725'. Before shooting the well produced 12 barrels oil in 8 hours swabbing. After shooting and cleaning out to bottom, the well produced 10 barrels oil in 8 hours swabbing and swabbed dry. After acidizing on 12-2-38 with 1,000 gallons of Dowell XFW acid no increase was noted. After re-acidizing on 12-3-38 with 5,000 gallons Dowell acid, the well produced 98 barrels of pipe line oil in 24 hours swabbing.
