DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OF WORKS OFFICE

Total depth - 4860' Lime.

This well was shot on 7-22-38 with 420 quarts of nitroglycerine from 4452' to 4750'. Before shooting the well produced 2 bbls. oil in 10 hours swabbing. After shooting and cleaning out it swabbed dry.

On 7-29-38 it was treated with 2000 gallons of Dowell XX acid and produced 32 bbls. oil in 24 hours swabbing after the treatment. It was retreated on 7-31-38 with 3000 gallons of Dowell XX acid but the production was not increased by this treatment.

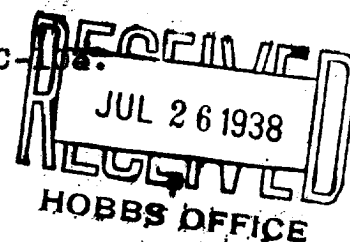

Anticipate shooting this well with approximately 420 quarts of nitroglycerine from 4452' to 4750' in an effort to make a commercial producer of this well.

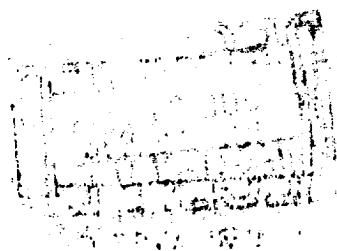
