### DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

T. D. 4760' Lime.

This well was acidized on 5-3-40 with 3000 gallons acid. Before acidizing, it produced 2.7 bbls. oil in 24 hrs. swabbing. After acidizing there was some increase in the gas but no increase in oil. After re-acidizing on 5-6-40 with 8000 gallons the well produced 6.72 bbls. oil in 24 hours swabbing. Since that time the well has produced approximately 2 bbls oil per day flowing. The well will be tested with pumping equipment in the near future.

This well was shot on 4-28-40 with 240 quarts of nitroglycerine from 4592 to 4720. Shot was tamped with gravel, and hole loaded with oil.

Prior to shooting, the well would produce approximately 3 bbls. oil per day. After shooting and cleaning out to bottom, the well produced 2.70 bbls PL Oil in 24 hours sw abbing.
