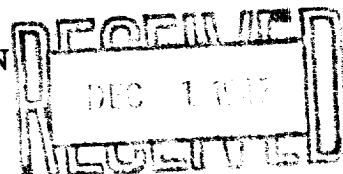

1. The purpose of this study was to determine the effect of a single dose of 100 mg of diazepam on the heart rate and blood pressure of patients with a recent myocardial infarction.

2. The study was conducted in a hospital setting, and the patients were recruited from the medical ward.

3. The study was approved by the Institutional Review Board, and all patients gave informed consent.

4. The study was conducted over a period of 12 weeks, and the results were analyzed using a t-test.

5. The results of the study showed that a single dose of 100 mg of diazepam significantly reduced the heart rate and blood pressure of patients with a recent myocardial infarction.

6. The study was limited by the small number of patients and the short duration of the study.

7. The study was funded by the National Institutes of Health, and the results were published in the Journal of the American Medical Association.
