Complete at 2:45 AM Sept. 27th, 1937. Swabbed thru tubing until Sept. 30th.  
Swabbed dry. Pulled tubing & packer. Swabbed dry by swabbing thru casing.  
Let well stand for 12 hours on the night of Oct. 4th to 5th, 1937. Ran  
swab to bottom of 7" casing on morning of Oct. 5, 1937, and found no  
fluid. Shut down awaiting authority to plug.
