We have received your request for approval to make the repairs on the above referenced well.

You may start the repairs on the well as soon as you determine the location of the holes in the casing, and the proper method to be used to bring the well into compliance with Oil Conservation Division standards.

We request 24 hours notice prior to the procedure in order to witness the operation and the pressure test upon completion of repairs.

After the repairs are completed, you are to submit a subsequent report (C-103) confirming the type of repairs, such as depth of the holes, cement used to squeeze off the leaks and/or other procedures used to make the repairs.
