Detailed account of work done, nature and quantity of materials used, and results obtained.

Pump well down and inject a mixture of 55 gallons of Cheplex in 500 gallons of 5% Hydrochloric acid into the tubing casing annulus. After a period of 24 hours pull rods and tubing. Frac open hole 4456' to 4786' in 3 stages, each of 10,000 gallons refined oil and 10,000 pounds of sand, with 1000 pounds of moth balls between stages at 17.5 BPM. Job complete 9:50 A.M. March 14, 1961. Recover load oil, test and return well to production.

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
