REPORT ON RESULT OF PLUCGING OF WELL

State of New Mexico "D" NCT-2 Well No. 2 (Cont'd)

Completed drilling February 32, 1948, without encountering commercial gas or oil horizons. Well was salvaded, plusted and abandoned as follows: Spotted cament plugs: 35 sacks, 4900-4600'; 15 sheks, 4275-4225', (in the bottom of the 5-1/2" casing) Parted and pulled 1181' of 5-1/2" casing and spotted cament plugs as follows: 35 sacks, 1250-1150' (in the top of the parted 5-1/2" casing) 30 sacks, 950-850'. Plugred top of hole with 15 sacks of cament from 100' to top (in 8-5/6" casing), camenting usual 4" x 10' pipe marker extending 4' above ground level, and leaving all 8-5/6" casing camented in the hole. Hole was filled with heavy mud between carent plugs, and all mud and carent was pumped in through drill plpe and tubing. Rigged Up to SP&A 4-15-48. Completed SP&A 4-20-48.

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
