FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK
(FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS)

To increase production we propose to do the following work:

1. Pump well down and inject mixture of 55 gallons of Cheplex and 500 gallons of 5 percent hydrochloric acid down tubing-casing annulus.
2. After a period of 24 hours, pull rods and tubing.
3. Fracture open hole section from 4103' to 4710' down 3-inch tubing with packer set at 4060' in 2 stages; each of 10,000 gallons of refined oil carrying one pound of sand per gallon with 750 pounds of flaked naphthalene temporary plugging material between stages.
4. Recover load oil, test, and return to production.
