DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Total Depth, 4710' - 5-1/2" casing cemented at 4213'

Well was shot on 1-6-45 with 460 quarts of liquid nitro-glycerine from, 4520' to 4702', using a 1-1/2 yard gravel tamp. The production of this well completed as a small producer 6-15-44, declined and the well would not consistently produce top allowable (46 Bbls.). After shooting and cleaning out well pumped 113 Bbls. of pipe line oil in 24 hours on 2-5-45.
