Total Depth 4710' - 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " casing set and cemented at 4213' with 300 sacks; well was completed June 15, 1944 producing at rate of 5 barrels per hour. Production has declined to the extent that it is making very little more than the current allowable. We, therefore desire permission to shoot this well from 4705' to 4520' with approximately 460 quarts.
