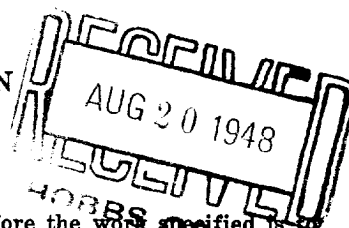

TD: 4725' Lime

Set and cemented 4391' (138 jts.) 5-1/2" casing at 4399' with 600 sacks and drilled out to 4725'. Ran 2" EUE tubing to 4717' with packer at 4052. Well swabbed at rate of 1.5 bbls. oil per hour.

We now desire to acidize with 2500 gals. 15% CP acid from 4399' to 4725'.
