Dowell xx. Bled 36 bbls oil off casing while introducing
acid thru tubing, controlling treatment from total depth to
4190'. Flushed tubing with 19 bbls. oil. Swabbed 6 hours
off bottom, recovered 157 bbls. oil load and acid and well
started flowing. Flowed 109 bbls. fresh oil in 7 hours and
was shut in one hour to clean a tank. Opened well and flowed
126 bbls. oil in 8 hrs. Casing pressure ranged from 75# at
start of test to 125# at end of test. Gas estimated at
400,000 cu. ft. daily.
