DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

T. D. 4655 Lime. Loaded hole with 150 bbls. oil & introduced 1000 gal. Dowell XX. Eled 20 bbls. oil off casing while introducing acid thru tubing, controlling treatment from total depth back to 4190'. Flushed tubing with 8 bbls. oil and started swabbing. Swabbed out 217 bbls. oil, oil load and acid in 8 hours swabbing off bottom. At the end of the 8th hour of swabbing the well started flowing and flowed 63 bbls. oil, 0 water in 6 hours. Gas was not measured. The well was then shut in to prepare for a second treatment with 4000 gal. Dowell XX.
