T. D. 4721 Lime. With annular space above packer set 4018' full oil introduced 750 gal. Dowell XXF6 & 750 gal. Dowell XXF6. Flushed tubing with 25 bbls. oil. Swabbed off bottom 12 hours, recovered 71 bbls. oil, oil load & acid, of which 9 bbls. was fresh oil.

Well was then shut in to prepare for another acid treatment.
