T. D. 4638 Lime. With annular space above packer set at 4018' full oil introduced 1750 gal. Dowell XXW1F6 and 750 gal. Dowell XXF6. Flushed tubing with 25 bbls. oil. Swabbed oil load & acid into pits 18 hours, no gauge. Swabbed 1/2 bbls. fresh oil hourly two hours. Well was then shut in to pull tubing and deepen.
