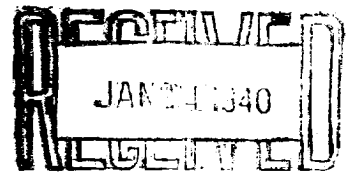

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

T. D. 4638 **Lime.** Acidized well from bottom of 7" casing set at 4091' to total depth with 1000 gal. Dowell XXWF-6. Flushed tubing with 18 bbls. oil. Swabbed out oil load & acid in 6 hrs. & treated with second stage of 1500 gal. Dowell XXWF-6. Flushed tubing with 18 bbls. oil. Swabbed off bottom 8 hours, recovered 58 bbls. oil load & acid. Next 6 hours swabbed 4-1/2 bbls. fresh oil, no water. Well was then shut in to prepare for another acid treatment.
