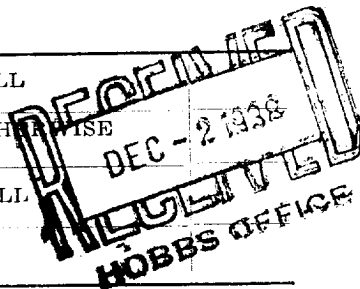

## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

T. D. # 4715 Line. Loaded hole with 140 bbls. oil & introduced 1000 gal. Dowell XL. Opened tubing until acid was on bottom & then closed tubing, treating only a few feet on bottom. Rigged up and swabbed 180 bbls. oil load, acid & fresh oil in 33 hours. 15 bbls. of recovery figured as fresh oil. Shut well in after swabbing 33 hours to prepare for a second acid treatment with 4000 gallons Dowell "XX".
