## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

T.D. 4655 Lime. With annular space above packer set at 4140' loaded with oil, introduced 4000 gal. Dowell XXWF-6. Flushed tubing with 46 bbls. oil. Rigged up & swabbed 15 hours off bottom, recovered 142 bbls. oil, oil load & acid & well started flowing. Flowed 70 bbls. fresh oil, no water in 7 hours. Well died at end of 7 hours. Ran swab 3 times off bottom & well started flowing again. Flowed 123 bbls. fresh oil, no water in 9 hours. Gas measured 202 MCF daily. Gas-oil ratio 592.
