T. D. 4655 Lime. With annular space above packer set at 4140' loaded with oil, introduced 3000 gal. Dowell XXWF-6. Flushed tubing with 24 bbls. oil. Swabbed off bottom 8 hours, recovered 96 bbls. oil load & acid & well started flowing. Flowed 79 bbls. fresh oil in 8 hours. Gas was not measured. Well was then shut in to prepare for another acid treatment.
