FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

This well has been drilled to a total depth of 2033' with 7 5/8" OD casing set at 798' and cemented with 250 sacks. From TD 1600' to TD 2033' the formation is salt and anhydrite. At 1869' an air pocket was encountered and drilling to TD 2033' was with much difficulty. The well blew out causing the hole to cave badly and efforts to ream to bottom were unsuccessful. It is planned to pump heavy mud (exceeding 11#) into the hole filling up all open hole and up inside the cemented string of casing to within 100' of the surface; after which cement will be dumped on top of the mud and the hole filled to the bottom of the cellar; abandoning the hole made and moving tools 160' north and 140' west of the present site, and drilling an entirely new hole.
