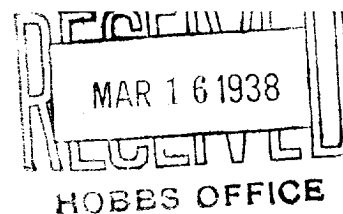

## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Well was killed with 33 tons of native clay pumped in with slush pumps. The top of the mud was 80' below the top of the surface pipe, or 718' up inside the surface string, from TD 2033'. The ~~wick~~ weight of this mud was 11.3# per gallon. 20 sacks of cement were dumped on top of the mud filling the hole to the top of the surface pipe.
