DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

With 7 5/8" casing set at 1513' and cemented ~~in~~ with 300 sacks on March 21st., the well was allowed to stand undisturbed for 72 hours.

Pump pressure was then applied, reaching a maximum of 1200#. The valves were then closed and the well allowed to stand undisturbed for 30 minutes. There was no drop in the pressure within the pipe.

Cement plug was then drilled and the same 1200# test pressure applied with like results. Drilling was resumed. 3-24-38
