FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

7 5/8" OD casing has been set at 1513' and cemented with 300 sacks of common cement. The well will be allowed to stand undisturbed for 72 hours.

On the morning of March 24th., casing and fittings will be tested by applying 1200# pump pressure. The valves will then be closed and allowed to stand undisturbed for thirty minutes. If there is no drop in pump pressure, the plug will then be drilled and the same test applied. If there is no drop in pump pressure, drilling will be resumed.
