With 10 3/4" casing set at 255' and cemented with 200 sacks, well was allowed to stand undisturbed for 72 hours. The cement plug was then drilled and the hole bailed dry. The hole was then allowed to stand undisturbed for one hour, after which a bailer was again run. There was no water present.

Drilling was resumed. 3-18-38.
