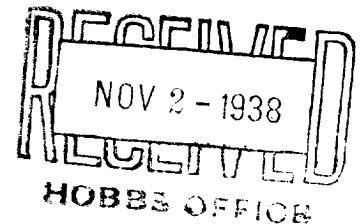

Anticipate drilling plug and testing casing by pressure method after 60 hours or at approximately 5:00 AM. 7-30-38.
