The above described well was drilled to a total depth of 14,784' for a Devonian test; and subsequently plugged back to a total depth of 13,555' on April 14, 1961, for Morrow production. The well was then completed on April 23, 1961, from the Morrow formation.

At the present time the Mescalero Unit #1 well is shut in awaiting further testing to enable El Paso Natural Gas Company to make an accurate determination of this well. At such time that these tests are concluded, this office will complete the required forms pertaining to the well and submit them to your office for approval.

Also, at that time we will submit the required and necessary forms to New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission requesting an allowable for this well.
