
Gentlemen:

Receipt is acknowledged of your "Notice of Intention to Drill" dated November 9, 1949 and amended Notice of Intention to Drill dated November 16, 1949, covering your Julia Brainard No. 1 well on the subject land in the center of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 19, T. 19S, R. 34E, Wildcat area, Lea County, New Mexico.

Your proposed work is approved subject to compliance with the provisions of the "Oil and Gas Operating Regulations" revised May 25, 1942, a copy of which has been furnished you, and subject to the following conditions:

1. Drilling operations so authorized are subject to the attached sheet for general conditions of approval.
2. Sufficient cement should be used in cementing the 13 3/8" casing to circulate to the surface.
3. The upper stage of cementing the 9 5/8" casing should be effected with not less than 250 sacks in the Anhydrite overlying the Salado salt section, to be determined by regular sampling of formations penetrated from 1000 feet to total depth.
4. Copies of sample log, electrical log, temperature and other surveys made are requested.
