We propose to plug as follows: 25 sack plug from 3215 to 3296 (base Salt 3255); 25 sack plug from 1785 to 1866 (top Salt 1825); 15 sack plug in bottom 8 5/8" casing from 115 to 190 feet; 5 sack plug in top 8 5/8" casing with 4" marker 4' high. Location to be cleaned and leveled.
