Receipt is acknowledged of "Notice of Intention to Drill" dated February 28, 1957, covering your well No. 1 (actually the second well on the lease) Hall Gillespie "B" on the subject leasehold in Lot 3 (NW 1/4) sec. 30, T. 19 S., R. 34 E., N.M.P.M., Wilcox, Lea County, New Mexico.

Your proposed work is approved subject to compliance with the provisions of the "Oil and Gas Operating Regulations" revised May 25, 1942, copy of which will be furnished you on request, and subject to the following condition:

1. Drilling operations so authorized are subject to the attached sheet (revised February 1955) for general conditions of approval.

As this well is only one location outside the Potash Area as defined by U. S. Oil Conservation Commission Order R-111 A, extra care should be taken in calculating the cement volume to be used on the 5 1/2" casing so that it will extend to at least 200' above the top of the salt section.

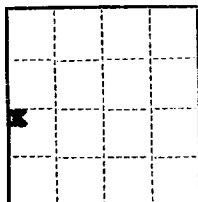

DETAILS OF WORK

We propose to drill at the above location with rotary to approximately 4000 feet or to sufficient depth to test the Seven Rivers. Surface pipe to consist of 10 3/4 inch casing cemented at approximately 350 feet with 350 sacks. Oil string to consist of 5 1/2 inch casing cemented at total depth with sufficient cement to extend 200 feet above the top of the salt section. Top of cement to be determined by temperature survey.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.

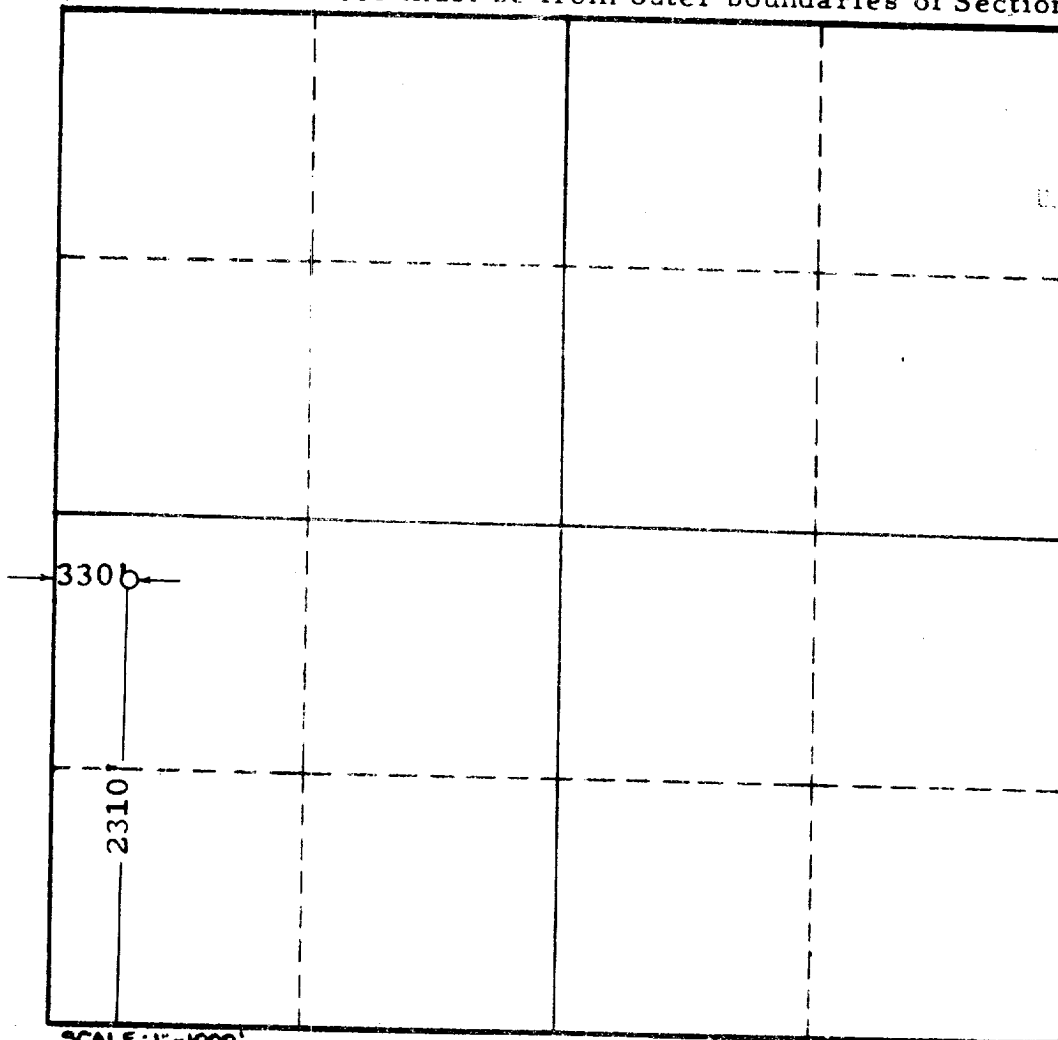
