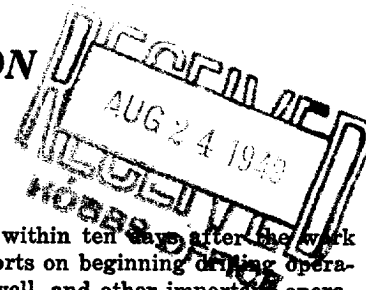

## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On August 13th, 16th, and 18th, 1949; 164.86, 225.47, and 75.07, respectively, net barrels of crude oil (total 465.40 barrels), 34 gravity were transferred from State E Tract 20 Lease, West Lovington Field, S-4, T-17, R-38, to State \*V\* #1, West Lovington Field, S-12, T-17, R-35 and used for acidizing operations in drilling well.
