FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

On August 12, 1949, at 1:30 p.m. 48 hours will have elapsed since running 4786' of 5½" casing set at 4774' and cemented with 520 sacks to be used as oil string. Pipe and water shut off will be tested by applying 1000 psi pressure and holding for 30 minutes before and after drilling cement plug. If pressure drop in excess of 100 psi occurs on either test proper remedial measures will be carried out. In event the above tests are satisfactory operations will be resumed. Top of cement will be determined by temperature survey.
