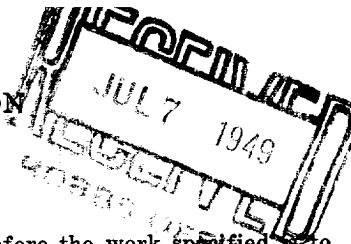

## FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

On July 6, 1949, at 12:01 p.m., 36 hours will have elapsed since running 288' of 13 3/8" casing set at 299' and cemented with 300 sacks to be used as surface string. At this time it is planned to test pipe and water shut off by applying 1000 PSI pressure and holding for 30 minutes, before and after drilling cement plug. If pressure drop in excess of 100 PSI occurs on either test, proper remedial measures will be carried out. In the event the above tests satisfactorily meet requirements, drilling will be resumed.
