## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

New 8 5/8" OD 28# H-40 casing was set at 1814'. It was cemented by Halliburton on March 23, 1950 with 75 sacks of cement around the casing shoe. Then a string of 1" pipe was run to a depth of 250' on the outside of the casing, through which 125 sacks of cement was circulated from that point back to surface.

A cable-tool rig was then rigged up and the cement plug was drilled on April 7, 1950. No water appeared and drilling continued.
