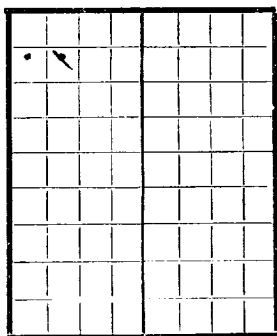

Rotary to about 1750'; Cable tools to about 1750' to total depth (about 4700')
