DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Broken oil pay was encountered in San Andres dolomite from 4560 to 4620' and from 4630 to 4652'. Total depth is 4656'. On March 10, 1950, the well swabbed 46 barrels of oil. On March 13, 1950, shot formation at 4560-4656' with 240 quarts of SOWE No. 1, using Calseal plug on top. While cleaning out, the tools stuck, and a fishing job resulted. We were never able to recover them, but we did drill by and drive the tools on down to 4651'; we then drilled by and made a new hole down to 4651'. After cleaning out to that point, the well swabbed and flowed 72 barrels of oil per day, and was completed and put on production on April 1, 1950.
