DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

On Nov. 19, 1949, 8 5/8" casing was set at 1805' and cemented with 75 sacks around the casing shoe. Then a string of 1" pipe was run to a depth of 250' on the outside of the casing, through which 125 sacks of cement was circulated from that point back to surface. The rotary rig was moved off the location.

Cable tools were moved on the location, and the cement plug was drilled on Jan. 17, 1950. No water appeared in the hole, and drilling is continuing.
