T.D. 4760. Western Company treated San Andres Formation from 4397' to 4760' with 5000 gallons acid. Flushed with 18-1/2 barrels oil. Maximum tubing pressure 2100#, minimum 200#. Maximum casing pressure 2150#, minimum 200#. Swabbed 6 hours to pits recovering flush oil and acid water. Swabbed to tanks 5 hours, 18 barrels formation oil. Shut in 13 hours, tubing pressure 300#. 1-6-52 Swabbed 10 hours, 40 barrels oil, 45 barrels acid water.
