Drilled well to 4400'. Ran 146 joints, 4387' of 5-1/2" OD casing set at 4397'. Cemented with 877 sacks 8% regular cement followed by 50 sacks neat. Pumped plug to 4366'. Cement circulated to surface. Tested casing with 1000# for 30 minutes before and after drilling plug. No pressure loss.
