DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

T. D. 4578 Line. Treated pay formation from 4268' 4" to total depth with 1000 gal. Dowell "XX". After introducing 1000 gal. started swabbing. Swabbed 150 bbls. oil load & acid in 15 hours on June 12th. Swabbed off bottom. June 13th swabbed 202 bbls. oil load, acid & fresh oil in 18 hours. Well flowed one head of 40 bbls. oil in 15 minutes. No water. Gas was not measured. Shut in casing pressure before flowing 475#, after flowing 160#. Well died after 15 minutes and swabbing was resumed.
