DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

6 5/8" seamless casing was set @ 4255' and cemented w/ 200 sacks of El Toro cement on 11/16/38. The well was allowed to stand undisturbed for a period of 72 hours. Pump pressure of 1200# was then applied to the pipe and fittings, the valves closed and the pressure within the pipe and fittings observed for a period of 30 minutes. There was no drop in pressure. The cement plug was then drilled and 1200# pressure test again applied. Again there was no drop in pressure. Drilling was resumed 11-17-38.
