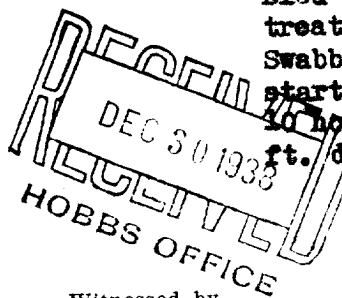

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

T. D. 4665 Limb. Loaded hole with 180 bbls. oil & introduced 4000 gal. Dowell XX. Bled 32 bbls. oil off casing while introducing acid thru tubing, controlling treatment from 4270' to total depth. Flushed tubing with 19 bbls. oil. Swabbed 6 hours off bottom, recovering 100 bbls. oil load & acid and well started flowing. Flowed 71-1/2 bbls. oil load & acid in 6 hours. Next 10 hours flowed 105 bbls. oil, no water. Gas estimated at 450,000 cu. ft. daily.
