DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

8-5/8" casing was cemented at depth of 1572' with 150 sax on bottom and 150 sax through 2" line pipe spotted at depth of 210'. Cement allowed to set 48 hours. Plug was drilled and hole bailed dry. Allowed to stand several hours and bailer was run again—hole found dry.
